PARENT ETHICS AGREEMENT

The River City Youth Soccer League has adopted a policy of sportsmanship for Players and Adults. This policy will be strictly enforced by the River City Youth Soccer League [RCYSL] Sportsmanship Committee. Parents should read, understand and e-sign this form prior to their children participating in our league.

By electronically signing this form I agree:

- 1. I will remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for youth, not adults.
- 2. I will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.
- 3. I will learn the rules of the game and the policies of the League.
- 4. I (and my guests) will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game, practice or other sporting event.
- 5. I (and my guests) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player, or parent Including but not limited to: booing and taunting; refusing to shake hands; or using profane language or gestures.
- 6. I will not encourage any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health and well-being of the athletes.
- 7. I will respect the officials and their authority during games and will never question, discuss, or confront coaches or referees at the game field. If needed I will fill out an online Match Report Form and notify the proper club and league officials.
- 8. I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco, and alcohol and I will refrain from their use at all sports events.
- 9. I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices unless I am a rostered coach for the team.
- 10. I will only register my child on ONE TEAM during the playing season. I understand that registering my child on multiple teams will result in my child being banned for the season and the teams involved will forfeit all games won.
- 11. I will notify my Club Registrar, as soon as possible in writing or via email, if my child is unable to participate for the registered season. I understand that my child may be dropped after the 3rd game of the season, from his/her assigned team, if s/he has not participate in any practices or games up to that point.
